Ipswich Original Ale

A New England classic, this is a medium-bodied, unfiltered English style pale ale with subtle earthy hoppiness and smooth malty flavor 5.4% ABV 16oz \$7

Ipswich Route 101 IPA

This hop forward, west coast style IPA packs a citrus-like punch with an understated malt backbone. 6.0% ABV 16oz -\$7

Ipswich Oatmeal Stout

Deep, rich, and malty with hints of chocolate and coffee. It's what espresso would be if it had the gumption to be beer 7.0% ABV 16oz -\$7

Ipswich Pilsner

There's no question about it. If you are looking for a refreshing light craft-brewed Pilsner, ours is a ray of sunshine! Golden pale color with malty sweetness made with traditional Czech Saaz hops 4.6% ABV 16oz - \$7
